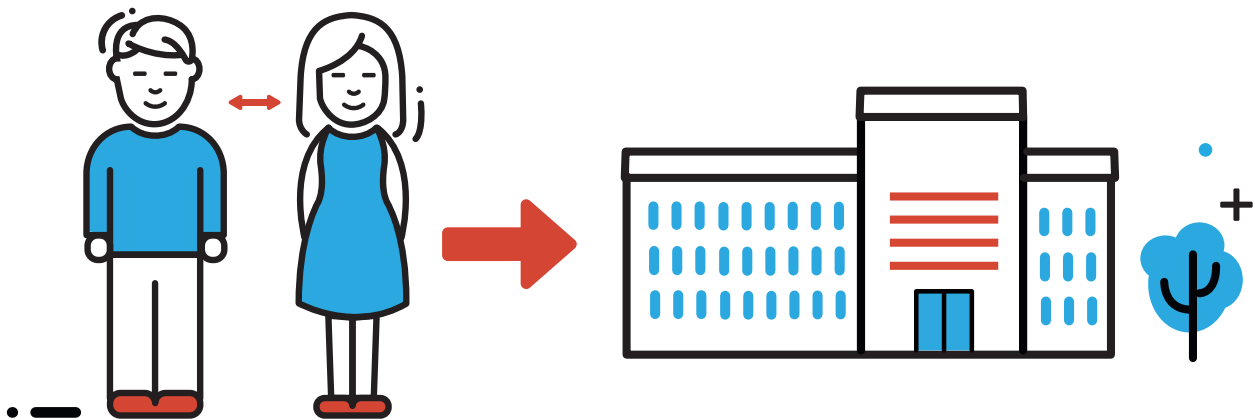

# CORONAVIRUS COVID-19 INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

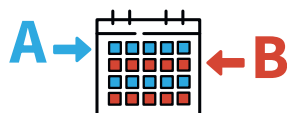
## ON 11 MAY 2020 YOUR CHILD RETURNS TO HIGH SCHOOL.

**The objective is to allow each student to**

- successfully complete the school year,
- prepare effectively for the next year.

**The priority is to protect everyone's health.**

## FOR THE RESUMPTION OF CLASSES 10 RULES APPLY:



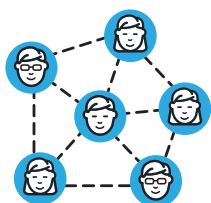
### **Alternation:**

Your child attends high school every other week.



### **50% fewer students:**

Each class is divided into group A and group B. When group A is at school, group B is at home.



### **Classes in high school:**

When in high school, your child reviews what he or she has studied during distance learning and learns new content.



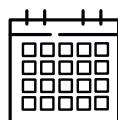
### **Home rehearsal:**

During the week at home, your child reviews the content learned during the week at school. Specific instructions will be given by the teachers.



### **The most important:**

The teaching focuses on what is essential to know for the next school year.



### **One semester:**

The second and third terms become one semester, going from 6 January to 14 July.



### **Tests in the main subjects:**

Your child will take tests in languages, mathematics and the specialisation subjects of the different sections.

### **No tests in other subjects:**

During distance learning, your child was asked to complete projects or assignments in these subjects. These are finalised in class and evaluated by a numerical mark. No test will be held.



### **Calculation to the students' advantage:**

If your child has at least two marks in a discipline, the lowest mark is not taken into account in the calculation of the average. Did he/she do well during distance learning? Teachers can add 1 to 4 bonus points to the average for the January-July 2020 semester.

**Example:** Calculating the average in mathematics

Tests	No. 1	No. 2	No. 3
Mark	42	<del>28</del>	50
Average	92 : 2 = 46		



### **Holidays maintained:**

The dates of the Pentecost holiday (30 May - 7 June) and the summer break (16 July - 14 September) do not change.

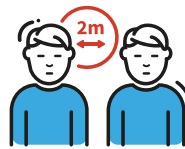
# CORONAVIRUS COVID-19 INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

To ensure the best possible protection of pupils and teachers,  
**9 BARRIER MEASURES ARE IMPOSED ON ALL.**



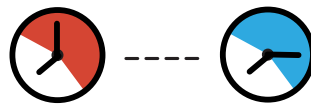
Pupils always remain in the **same group**, A or B.

In the classrooms everyone respects the **interpersonal distance of 2 metres**.



During **the journey to school** and when **moving within the school**, wearing a **mask**, a bandana (buff) or a scarf covering the mouth and nose is **compulsory**.

**In the classroom**, covering the mouth and nose is **optional**.



Breaks and recess are **alternated**.

**Regular handwashing** is reminded and encouraged.



**Sanitizers** are available in every classroom and at school entrances.

**Physical education and swimming classes** are **cancelled** until the end of the school year.



**Vulnerable students** may continue with distance education, upon presentation of a **medical certificate**.
