

Non-graduating classes CCP, DAT, DT



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
ON 11 MAY 2020 YOUR CHILD RETURNS TO VOCATIONAL EDUCATION AND TRAINING.

The objective is to allow each student to

- progress in his schooling,
- successfully complete the school year,
- prepare effectively for the next year.

The priority is to protect everyone's health.

FOR THE RESUMPTION OF CLASSES 10 RULES APPLY:



Alternation:

Your child attends high school every other week.



50% fewer students:

Each class is divided into group A and group B. When group A is at school, group B is at home or at the training company.



Classes in high school:

When in high school, your child learns new content.



Home rehearsal:

During the week at home, your child reviews the content learned during the week at school



The most important:

The teaching focuses on what is essential to know for the next school year.



Tests after consolidation

of learning:

reviews with the teacher what he/she has studied during distance learning. After this review, tests may take place.



Passed employer training modules:

Apprentices are exempted from the employer training modules of the second semester. These modules are therefore considered as passed.



Students in non-graduating classes are exempted from all internship modules. These modules are therefore passed.




A return to the company according to the sector:

If your child is undertaking an apprenticeship, he/she can return to his/her training company under certain conditions: the sector of activity is deconfined, his/her protection is guaranteed and he/she can benefit from the same coaching as before the interruption of classes.

On the days where he/she doesn't attend school, he/she goes to the training company.

If he/she is undertaking a crossborder apprenticeship (school abroad, apprenticeship in Luxembourg), he/she returns to school when it reopens, and starts at the company at the earliest on 11 May.





Holidays maintained:

The dates of the Pentecost holiday (30 May - 7 June) and the summer break (16 July - 14 September) do not change.

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To ensure the best possible protection of students and teachers,

9 BARRIER MEASURES ARE IMPOSED ON ALL.



Students always remain in the **same group**, A or B.

and nose is **compulsory**.

In the classrooms everyone respects the **interpersonal distance of 2 metres**.





During the journey to school and when moving within the school, wearing a mask, a bandana (buff) or a scarf covering the mouth

In the classroom, covering the mouth and nose is **optional**.







Breaks and recess are **alternated**.

Regular handwashing is reminded and encouraged.





Sanitizers are available in every classroom and at school entrances.

Physical education and swimming classes are **cancelled** until the end of the school year.





Vulnerable students may continue with distance education, upon presentation of a **medical certificate**.
